Government Camp To Be Revitalized into a World-Class Tourist Destination

Mt. Hood LLC builds Collins Lake Resort on Mount Hood - vacation chalets with a proposed master plan including a hotel, conference center and aerial tramway

PORTLAND, Ore.—September 30, 2003 - Portlander Kirk Hanna's hard work has persevered during the past 14-years and his master plan is coming to fruition in the Village of Government Camp. Another well-known Portlander, Junki Yoshida, founder of the Yoshida Group, has also invested in Mt. Hood LLC and will be a part of its vision to bring a world-class tourist resort to Oregon.

Mt. Hood LLC is building Collins Lake Resort with 171 mountain chalets and has so far received dozens of paid reservations. The phased community consists of 25 buildings plus a variety of site amenities, all approved by Clackamas County in January 2001. "This idea has been a long time coming. We have all the approvals in place and our model home building sites are under construction. Oregon needs a world-class tourist destination location with year-round recreational opportunities and we hope to be a vital part of making that dream come true", said Kirk Hanna, one of the owners of Mt. Hood LLC.

Mr. Hanna is an original member of the Government Camp Revitalization Project formed in 1989 to manage the use of Tax Increment Financing (TIF). Government Camp's water and sewer infrastructure has already been expanded to handle the anticipated development. New street lighting, facades, landscaping, signage improvements, development of snow management facilities, and pedestrian access improvements will be implemented in the core area of Government Camp next summer.

"I feel honored to be a partner in such an exciting project," stated Junki Yoshida, CEO and Chairman of the Yoshida Group. "Collins Lake Resort will undoubtedly provide more opportunity for visitors and Oregonians to truly enjoy the natural beauty that our state has to offer."

An integral element of the revitalized Village of Government Camp is the proposed aerial tramway, planned to connect Timberline Lodge to Hanna's Mt. Hood Skibowl. The genesis of the tramway goes back to 1976 when the University of Oregon created the Mt. Hood Community Plan as a means to limit the traffic and environmental impact to the area. In 1989, the TIF Revitalization Program kept the idea alive, and in 1999 ODOT directed a Mt. Hood Transit Feasibility Study. Mr. Hanna conducted a Government Camp Tramway Proposal in 2003 and more specific research is still underway.

Mr. Hanna's other company, H-Ski Corporation has owned Mt. Hood Skibowl, since 1987. A pioneer in creating resort recreational opportunities, Hanna was the first to see the year-round potential for Mt. Hood. For more information on Mt.
